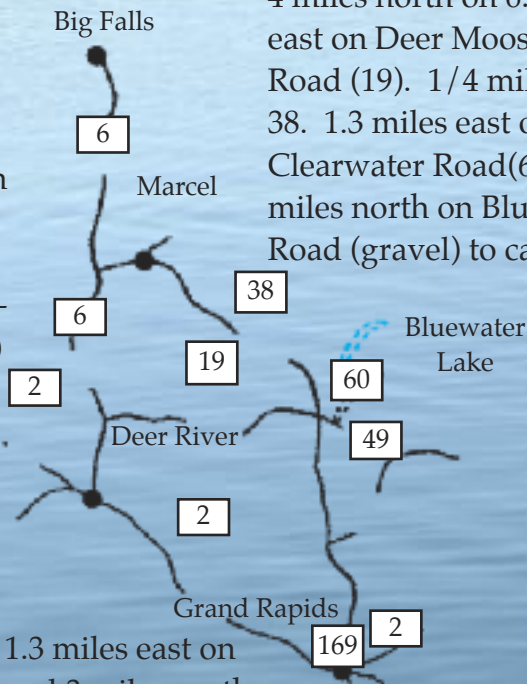


From Big Falls
