About the LIT Program

Bluewater's Leaders in Training program offers an opportunity for students to develop leadership skills in a camp setting. Students will serve alongside various staff members as they build relationships with campers of an assigned cabin through meals, chapel times, and cabin devotions; work on projects such as splitting wood and cleaning; and participate in leadership training sessions. A trained staff member will supervise and lead the students. Some sessions will also be led by the Camp Director and Program Director. In this small group setting (6 students), students will not only listen and study leadership skills, but also be able to put those skills into practice immediately at camp. Students will sleep in tents, so pack accordingly!



Who is eligible?

Students must be entering grades 10-12 and have their applications and references turned in. We will have spots for 6 students during each session so space will fill up fast!

\$120
